## To the Promotion Committee:

I am writing to recommend Joyce Treulieb for promotion to Professor of Mathematics. Joyce demonstrates her extra commitment and contribution to students, and the overall Steamboat CMC campus, by providing volunteer math tutoring.

For the duration of the 2021-2022 academic year and thus far in the current academic year, Joyce has hosted her office hours in the Tutoring Center (formerly referred to as the Learning Lab), for 4-6 hours a week. Joyce offers tutoring support to any level math student. While some of these drop-in students are her own students, most are not. Interestingly, several other faculty have followed Joyce's lead and are providing their office hours in the Tutoring Center as well.

This model, envisioned by Joyce, saves the college thousands of dollars a year, and provides an invaluable service to our students. It is my rough estimate that Joyce's contribution alone is valued at \$4,000-\$6,000/academic year. So far this school year, as of October 27, 2022, Joyce has had 34 separate tutoring encounters and many repeat visits. Our evaluation efforts show that working with a tutor improves grades and/or test scores as well as confidence and knowledge in the material and/or assignment. One student claimed that she would have failed her math class without Joyce's help and that her grade improved from an F to a B. I am sure if I interviewed more students, I would get similar feedback.

In conclusion, I am grateful to Joyce. Her help in the Tutoring Center is significant. It also exhibits that she is a team player who cares about CMC and our students. I believe these would be important characteristics to factor in when considering an individual for a promotion.
